#### Quantity:

A single batch of chili totaling at least 2 gallons (256 ounces) is required. Chili must be cooked to 165 before arrival and kept at or above 140 degrees during entire tasting time.

#### Process:

Tasting Kits will be sold by RCEF, for \$5, consisting of one 2 ounce sample cup, spoon, tickets for 4 tastings and one People's Choice ballot. People's Choice ballot containers will be provided to each competitor by RCEF. When tasting period begins, tasters will provide one ticket to the competitor in exchange for one filling of the sample cup. Tasters may buy extra taste tickets and people choice ballots for a fee.

2 pm Tasting begins. All booths open for tasting at the same time. No early samples, please.

6 pm Votes tallied- Judging results and Awards Ceremony
